Our first 'Man Alive' event of the new session features Morgan Jamieson. Morgan has had a highly successful career specialising in cardiac surgery with a particular interest in children's heart surgery, as Medical Director of Yorkhill Children's Hospital and subsequently as the Scottish Government's first ever appointee as National Clinical Lead in Children and Young People's Health. After initial medical training in Edinburgh, Morgan spent time working in Great Ormond Street Hospital London, in Glasgow and in South Africa.



Since retiring in 2009 he has been involved with the work of the Children's Panel and has undertaken a Divinity Degree at Aberdeen University. Morgan is married to Maggie and is very involved in the life and leadership of Newton Mearns Baptist Church. Morgan will share stories about his fascinating career including his current work as Chair of the Board of the Nazareth Trust, a Scottish Christian charity that has been serving the people of Nazareth since 1861.
